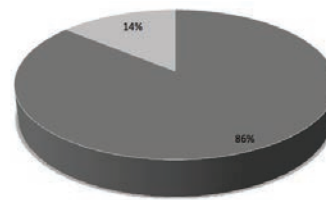
DIANE FOX RETIRES FROM TFT BOARD

Tools For Tomorrow is indeed privileged to have this talented, generous man as one of our teachers.



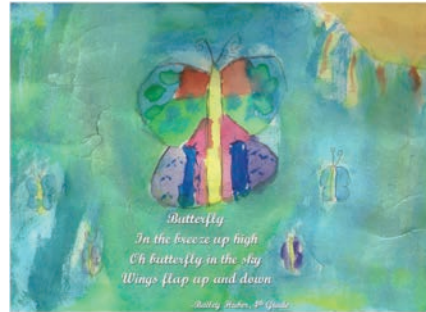

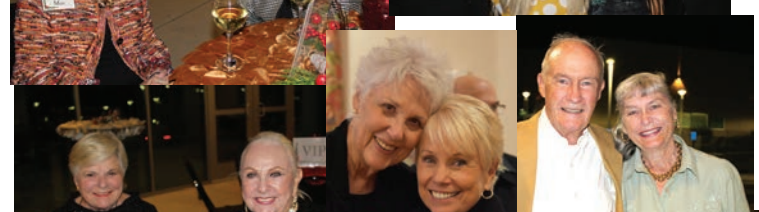

While there are many worthy charities in the Coachella Valley we are thankful that you choose to support Tools For Tomorrow.

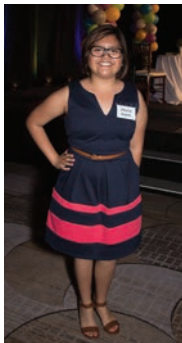

Which schools can we serve?

All Coachella Valley elementary schools are eligible. We are currently operating programs in Cathedral City, Coachella, Desert Hot Springs, Indio, La Quinta, Palm Desert, Palm Springs, Rancho Mirage, and Mecca.

What are the program costs?

\$10,000 supports the full program in a school for one school year.
