## A REPORT FROM OUR PROGRAM DIRECTOR



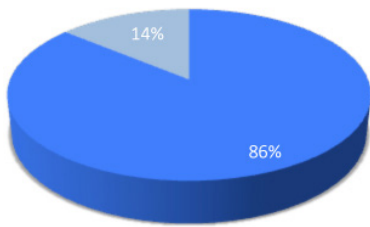

The true test of any person or group's character is how they respond when challenged by adversity. At Tools For Tomorrow we were suddenly presented with a situation beyond our control which threatened our mission at a time when the students needed us more than ever.

When it became clear last fall that schools would not reopen we had a decision to make. Throughout the summer of 2020 we trained teachers and reworked our systems in order to offer our program online. Many of our procedures had to be reimaged, and with a few small glitches we were able to continue classes at all of our schools. Response was better than we hoped as we registered well over three hundred students. We also found that by providing online classes we can make Tools For Tomorrow programs available to students throughout the district, thus serving more children than ever.

Our program has been blessed with the support of an incredibly generous network of volunteers, mentors, and donors whose help was crucial. I see the fruits of our labor every day in the faces of the students we serve. I thank you from the bottom of my heart. *David Hirsch*
