A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT





When it became clear last fall that

schools would not reopen we had a decision to make. Throughout the summer of 2020 we trained teachers and reworked our systems in order to offer our program online. Many of our procedures had to be reimagined, and with a few small glitches we were able to continue classes at all of our schools. Response was better than we hoped as we registered well over three hundred students. We also found that by providing online classes we can make Tools For Tomorrow programs available to students throughout the district, thus serving more children than ever.
